To all members of the Team,

Here is the information regarding the Finals and the U13-AAA All Star Game, at the Bell Centre.

Firstly, it is important to specify that the organization of the Celebration will use the Team Roster (HCR) to determine the official list of players and coaching staff (i.e., head coach, assistant coaches, and manager). Only the identified players and the 5 members of the coaching staff will have access to the player's room. Please bring both of your team's jersey colors and your water bottles.

Parents and accompanying individuals for each of the teams will have access to the stands at the Bell Centre to attend the games. The tournament pass or the daily pass must be presented upon arrival at the Bell Centre.

Please ensure that throughout the process, managers, parents, coaches, and players stay informed about all the details of the day. You can always follow the results of the Celebration on:

ORGANIZATIONAL DETAILS FOR THE FINAL AT THE BELL CENTRE

Arrival and Procedure for the games on December 17, 2023

You can easily enter through the indoor garage of the Bell Centre, adjacent to the employee entrance - **1225 Saint-Antoine Street W. The indoor parking at the Bell Centre will be open (At your expense - \$18).** You can access it from inside the Bell Centre garage near parking lots **A-110 or B-112** (a directional sign will be installed). You will need to climb stairs.

You can also arrive from the outside using the garage entrance located under the overpass on De La Montagne Street (adjacent to the Bell Centre). We ask you to temporarily park your vehicle in front of the garage to unload the players and equipment before parking in nearby streets or lots. The team must proceed with its registration upon arrival. Players and coaches will be escorted to the locker room, while parents, friends, and accompanying individuals will be asked to go to the stands following the instructions.

Teams can come to the Bell Center by bus. The Bus will be able to park temporarily in front of the De La Montagne garage and bring the players down with their equipment. A few parking spaces are available for buses on the streets adjacent to the Bell Centre.

Players and coaches must enter through the De La Montagne Garage; the team must register upon arrival. Players and coaches will be escorted to the locker room while parents and family members will be asked to go to the stands.

Each team must respect the scheduled arrival time at the Bell Centre, otherwise you will have to wait unnecessarily. That is, each team should arrive 45 minutes before their game. If you wish to arrive sooner, you can go to the stands to watch the other final games.

You will have access to the locker room only forty-five (45) minutes before your game and thirty (30) minutes after the game. **All travel by the team and its support staff inside the Bell Center must be done as a GROUP and accompanied by a manager at ALL TIMES.**



The entry for parents and friends will be through the De La Montagne Street garage or the main entrance at 1909 Canadiens-de-Montréal Avenue.

Entry is free for players, coaches, and team personnel (up to 5 people) participating in the Celebration. Spectators have the option to purchase the tournament pass available at the admission for \$20 or the daily pass for \$8. For individuals aged 65 and older, the daily pass is \$6, and the tournament pass is \$15. Children aged 12 and under can enjoy the Celebration for free.

Those who purchase the tournament pass will receive a bracelet that they must wear for the entire Celebration to access competition venues without having to present their proof of purchase again. We accept cash only at the entrance. It will also be possible to purchase your ticket via our Zeffy platform at any time upon your arrival at the arena.

All spectators will be grouped in the designated sections (in the red sections). Teams are entirely responsible for the conduct of their spectators, players, and coaching staff.

Please note that it is allowed to bring a camera and/or camcorder for the games during the Final. The matches will be filmed by the Bell Centre staff, and the match files will be shared later with all participating teams.

It is strictly prohibited to go on the ice to take photos.



Dressing Room

Each team will have its own dressing room 45 minutes before the game. Dressing rooms must be vacated 30 minutes after the match to allow enough time for cleaning before the arrival of the next teams. The schedule for the day will be very tight, so we ask for the cooperation of coaches to adhere to the timetable.

Concession

Throughout the event, a food concession stand will be open if you wish to purchase coffee, hot dogs, liquor, and other items.

Departure

Departure will be from the same location as arrival (De La Montagne Street garage). We ask parents and friends to meet the players at the garage 30 minutes after the game. Vehicles should be parked in front of the garage as during arrival for boarding and loading of equipment. If you wish to stay to watch other finals, you can place hockey equipment in the cars and return to the Bell Centre stands to watch the action.

FAQ

1. Can I invite someone to the game?

Yes, you can invite the number of people you want. Spectators will have access to the stands and concessions only.

2. Can I take pictures?

Yes, you are welcome to bring your cameras and take pictures of this unforgettable day at the Bell Centre.

3. Parking

The Bell Center indoor parking will be open (At your expense, 18\$ per vehicle)
Adjacent to the employee entrance – on Saint-Antoine Street.

Please note that the players' entrance is on De La Montagne Street. You can access it from inside the Bell Center garage near parking lots A-110 and B-112 (a directional sign will be installed)
