We are pleased to welcome you to the 9th edition of the Caroline Ouellette Girls Hockey Celebration from December 14th to the 17th, 2023.

OUR MISSION

The Caroline Ouellette Girls Hockey Celebration is a non-profit organization. All proceeds from the Celebration are reinvested in development of players, coaches and officials of women's hockey through our Player to Coach and Introduction to Officiating programs. We offer unique components such as on-ice development sessions for U9 goaltenders and players, the All-Star Alumni Game, the U15-AAA LHEQ All-Star Game, the U13-AAA All-Star Game, and the U18-AAA LHEQ game between the Richelieu Remparts and the Laurentides-Lanaudière Étoiles. We are proud to fully fund the participation of the Quebec Étoiles team taking part for the first time this year in the Quebec Women's Hockey Tournament in the U15-AAA division.

YOUR COMPETITION SITE IS THE ÉTIENNE-DESMARTEAU CENTER.

U9 and U15 Divisions Tournament is held at the Étienne-Desmarteau Center located at 3430 Bellechasse street in Montreal.

3 Divisions were formed in our U9 division this year. The U9 tournament format will be 3 games and one on-ice skills development session. The best four teams of each division will play in the semi-finals and the winners will move on to play in our U9 finals on Sunday December 17 at the Étienne-Desmarteau Center.

U11, U13 and U 15 Final Games and the U13-AAA All Star Game at the Bell Center

The finals of all our U11, U13 and U15 divisions and the U13-AAA All-Star Celebration Game will be held at the Bell Center thanks to a partnership with the Montreal Canadiens. All teams, families and friends are invited to attend the final games at the Bell Centre as spectators.

For your information, U11 and U13 Divisions Tournament is held at the DDO Civic Center located at 12001 Salaberry Blvd, Dollard-Des Ormeaux, QC H9B 2A7.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All game rules are also available using this [link](#). Be sure to read this information before the tournament and be aware of the procedure for games and overtime.

PLAYERS OF THE GAME & POST-GAME PROTOCOL.

Coaches are asked to provide the scorekeeper with the full name and number of the player of the game approximately 3 minutes before the end of the 3rd period. At the end of the game, we ask both teams to quickly greet each other with gloves on to avoid any unnecessary contact. Both teams will then line up on their respective blue lines for the presentation of the players of the game.

ÉTIENNE-DESMARTEAU CENTER – U9 AND U15 DIVISIONS

ENTRANCE TO THE RINK

When you arrive at the rink, you will see an entrance for players, coaches, officials and staff. A second separate entrance will be identified for parents and spectators.

TEAM REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place in the Rosemont room located between the two ice rinks. You must check in before each game to verify your game sheet and confirm your jersey color. Teams must bring their game sheets from their 5 last games. Please arrive no later than 75 minutes before your first game.

REGISTRATION OF INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS

Individual player registration will take place in the Rosemont room located between the two ice rinks. We will give you your team jersey and hockey socks before the first game. Coaches of individual teams must stop by the registrar before each game to have their players sign the game sheet. Please arrive no later than 75 minutes before your first game.

IMPORTANT PARKING

Welcome to Montreal where parking is always a challenge in municipal rinks. We encourage you to carpool or allow extra time to find a parking spot. The parking lot is located at CEGEP Rosemont in front of the rink but space is limited during the week.

We have negotiated a procedure on Thursday that will allow the gate to be open from 3:00 PM until the end of the day. This procedure will be the same on Friday for all Celebration activities. On Saturday and Sunday, free parking will be available at EMICA-Annexe School and Collège Jean-Eudes. See details below.

Important to consult the instructions for Parking by day:

Thursday, December 14: Gate opens starting at 3:00 PM. Unlimited parking spaces; the gate will remain open for the day until 11:45 PM.

Friday, December 15: Gate opens for the entire day. Unlimited parking spaces; the barriers will remain open for the day until 11:45 PM.

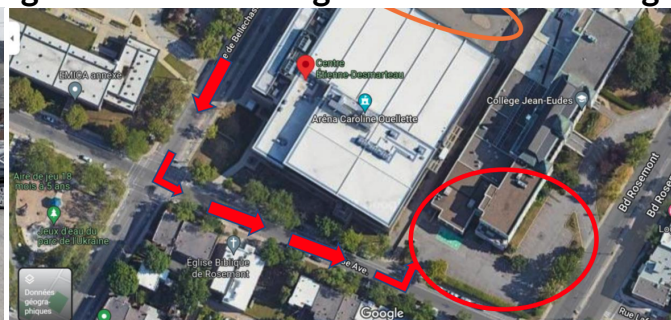
Saturday and Sunday, December 16-17:

Free parking is available at the EMICA-Annex school located just on the other side of Centre Étienne-Desmarteau, accessible via De Bellechasse Street. Parking at Collège Jean-Eudes at the corner of Rosemont Street and 13th Avenue will be available on December 16th and 17th.

At Rosemont College. There will be 140 free parking spaces available. Your participants must (without exception):

1. Go to the parking lot and pick up a ticket.
2. Validate the ticket inside the Etienne-Desmarteau Center to make the ticket free. Otherwise, the user will have to pay for parking.
3. We have the right to 140 parking spaces, the 141st will be payable.

There are also neighbouring streets to park on, but please be aware of municipal rules. We are not responsible for the consequences of not respecting the parking rules. Please note that De Bellechasse Street is one-way westbound.

TICKETS & TOURNAMENT PASSES

Admission is free for players, coaches and staff (up to 5 people) of teams participating in the Celebration. Spectators have the option of purchasing a tournament pass available at admission for \$20 or a day pass for \$8. For those 65 and older, the day pass is \$6 and the tournament pass is \$15.

Those who purchase a tournament pass will receive a wristband that they must wear for the entire Celebration to access the competition sites without having to re-present their proof of purchase. We accept cash only at the door. It will also be possible to purchase your ticket via our Zeffy platform at any time upon arrival at the arena.

Children 12 years and under will be able to enjoy the Celebration for free. All Celebration activities including the on-ice sessions, the Alumni game, the LHEQ M15-AAA All-Star game, M13-AAA All-Star game, and the LHEQ M18-AAA exhibition game are included in the cost of admission.

We conclude the Celebration with a U13-AAA All Star game for the selection of the Quebec Étoiles team taking part for the first time this year in the Quebec Women's Hockey Tournament in the U15-AAA division. We also offer on-ice development sessions for U9 players and goaltenders with Olympian Julie Chu. We run an initiation to hockey session called CCM Get in the Game for girls wanting to try hockey.

ON-ICE SKILL DEVELOPMENT SESSION FOR U9 PLAYERS AND GOALIES WITH OLYMPIAN JULIE CHU ON DECEMBER 16 AT ÉTIENNE-DESMARTEAU CENTER.

These sessions are conducted entirely by our coaching staff at the professional, university and collegial levels. Players and goalies must bring their jerseys and socks for these sessions. U9 goalies will be mentored by goalie coaches during these sessions.

PRO SHOP

The Pro Shop will be open during the Celebration and will offer skate sharpening services and will sell certain hockey related products.

ACTION PHOTOS AT THE GIRLS' HOCKEY CELEBRATION.

This year, photos in action will be available individually following the event. Most matches will be photographed, depending on the availability of our photographers. Packages for purchasing photos of a full match will also be available.

For individual purchases, photos will be added to an online gallery following the event at a price of \$13 each. A 13% discount will be offered on the purchase of 13 or more images.

For teams wishing to purchase photos of a complete match, a package is available for pre-sale. This way you will ensure that you have a photographer present during your match.

The package includes a minimum of 50 images and is offered at a cost of \$200.

U-15 FINALS AT THE BELL CENTRE ON DECEMBER 17th, 2023
