As an Olympic athlete, I learned at a very young age how to combine my academic duties with my athletic training and competitions. I acquired a discipline which allowed me to excel in each component and graduate with the highest honours at the University level while practicing my favourite sport on the international stage.

I believe in the power and influence hockey can have in shaping young athletes. The Girls Hockey Celebration allows future young stars in women's hockey to meet and learn from members of the National women's hockey team and from professional hockey players. These women are role models and are positive representations of academic and athletic successes. We hope to inspire young girls to believe in themselves and to dream of all the possibilities the sport of hockey has to offer to them.
